

Settlement Agreement with MEMC

September 5, 2012

Evonik Industries and its customer MEMC Electronic Materials have agreed to settle and resolve disputes related to two long-term take-or-pay supply agreements for the supply of trichlorosilane (TCS) to MEMC's Merano, Italy polysilicon facility. Pursuant to the settlement agreements, MEMC will pay Evonik a total of 70 million Euro in full settlement of all obligations under the terminated supply agreements.

As part of the settlement agreements, MEMC will acquire the Evonik TCS production plant, which is located on MEMC's Merano site.

"We had very fruitful discussions and came to the best solution for Merano as a production site of the silicon industry," states Michael Gatterman, Head of the Business Line Advanced Silanes and hence responsible for the TCS business. "We are sure to make a valuable contribution for the resume of the polysilicon production through this agreement with our customer."

Vergleichsvereinbarung mit MEMC

Evonik Industries und MEMC Electronic Materials haben sich auf einen Vergleich zur Auflösung zweier langfristiger Lieferverträge geeinigt. Die Verträge regelten auf der Grundlage festgelegter Mindestmengen die Belieferung des Meraner MEMC Werkes mit Trichlorsilan (TCS) von Evonik. MEMC stellt in Meran daraus polykristallines Silizium zur Verwendung in der Halbleiter- und Photovoltaikindustrie her. Evonik erhält aus der Vergleichsvereinbarung 70 Millionen Euro und verzichtet auf alle Rechte, die sich aus den betroffenen Lieferverträgen ergeben. Im Zuge dieses Vergleichs wird MEMC die Anlage zur Herstellung von TCS von Evonik übernehmen.
